6. Are there people in your city without access because they don’t speak English? How could you share the gospel with them?
7. What missionaries do you know bringing access to people who previously had none?
8. Since your neighbor has access through you have you shared the gospel with your neighbor? How did it go? If not, how could you share the gospel with them?
